

KEMPTON, EPHRAIM, 3d in the text; son Stephen m., 1705, Ruth Ingleden. OBEED, in the text, had son Obed W., 1839. EPHRAIM, 7th in the text, was son of 2d Thomas, not 1st. OLIVER, son of Oliver and grandson of 2d Samuel in the text, m., 1799, Sarah Harlow, and had Eliza O., 1802, m. Elias Cox. ZACHEUS, in the text, had also Isaac, m. Betsey C. Dillard. ZACHEUS, son of above, m., 1st, Abigail Cox, in 1819. He m., 2d, Harriette Hollister, 1823, and had Elizabeth, 1826; Amos W., 1828; Lucy A., 1830; Marian D., 1832. He m., 3d, Emeline Higley, 1836, and had Emeline, 1837; Rebecca, 1841; Emily Louisa, 1846; Jennett Keeny, 1848.

KENDALL, THOMAS, last in the text, of Boston, m., 1708, Sarah Cheever.

KENNEDY, JOHN, in the text, m. Esther Allen, wid. of Benjamin Robbins, and had James and Nancy. His wid. m. John Osgood.

KENT, SAMUEL, in the text, was son of John and Sarah (Smith) Kent and m. Desire Barker.

KEYES, AMAZIAH, son of an Abijah, was born 1771 and probably lived in Boston, where he m., 1794, Nancy, d. of Edward Crafts. He removed to Palmyra, N. Y. BENJAMIN, in the text, brother of above, m., 1796, Polly Norris. OLIVER, in the text, brother of above; son Oliver Shurtleff should be William Shurtleff.

KING, ISAAC B., in the text, was son of 2d John. JOHN, 1st in the text, came from Maryland. JOHN, 2d in the text; son Elisha should be Elihu; add children Isaac B. and Joanna E., 1813, m. Reuben Hall. WILLIAM, in the text, m. Susanna, d. of Robert Harlow.

KNEELAND, JOSHUA, in the text, was born 1792.

LANMAN, CHARLES JAMES, son of James below, born in Norwich, 1795, m., 1816, Mary J., d. of Antoine Guy, and had son Charles, who was secretary of Daniel Webster. JAMES, son of Peter and Sarah (Colt) Lanman, born in Norwich, 1769, m. Maria Griswold Chandler and Mary Judith Benjamin, mother of Park Benjamin. PETER, 1st in the text; d. Polly m. George Holmes Savery. SAMUEL, 1st in the text; son Nathaniel Cobb born 1793. SAMUEL, 2d in the text, m. 1811; d. Elizabeth m. Thomas C. Atwood.

LEACH, FINNEY, in the text; son Albert was Albert G. LEMUEL, 2d in the text; son Ezra born 1799; son Lemuel born 1805; son David, 1807; Reuben, 1809.

LEBARON, BARTLETT, in the text, m. wid. Mary Easdel; son James m. Mary, d. of Caleb Fiske; d. Nancy m. Phillip Taylor, of Penn.; d. Lucy m. Thomas Mayo. DAVID, son of 1st James, m. Martha Chatfield and had Solomon, 1766, m. Zada Hare; Francis, 1769, m. Sabrah Kelsey; Huldah, 1771, m. a Curtis; Martha, 1773, m. Tilley Gilbert; David, 1775; Lydia, 1777, m. Philander Nettleton; Ruth, 1779, m. Silas Fordham; Naomi, 1781; James, 1783, m. Louisa Adams; Daniel, 1785, m. Esther Welsey; Hannah, 1788, m. Daniel Higgins. FRANCIS, the 1st in the text, was not a Roman Catholic as has been often stated. The author has a letter in his possession dated Norfolk, Conn., June 5, 1882, from Mrs. Maria Humphrey, a gr. d. of Elizabeth Robbins, who was a gr. d. of Francis LeBaron.
