GEORGE, son of last William, below, m., 1814, Sarah, d. of Azor Phelps, of Sutton, Mass., and died in Albany, 1856; he had two children, one of whom was George William, born 1828. GEORGE WILLIAM, son of above, lived in Albany, Brooklyn and New York; he m., 1858, Mary Eliza, d. of Richard Henry Pearse, of Albany; he had six children, one of whom was Charles Elliot, born in Brooklyn, 1864. JAMES, son of Samuel in the text, born 1710, m., 1735, Mary Terry, of Freetown, and had Samuel, 1737; Mary, 1739; Cornelius, 1741; Gamaliel, 1744; James, 1745; he died in what is now Fall River about 1790. JOSEPH, 2d in the text, m. Mehitabel, d. of Edward Wilder. JOSHUA, son of Daniel and Mary (Barron) Warren, of Watertown, m., 1695, Rebecca, d. of Calvin Church; he was born in Waltham, 1608, and died in Watertown, 1760; he had twelve children born, among them Phineas, born 1718, in Waltham. NATHAN, son of Samuel, m. Keziah White, and had Nathan, who had a son Daniel, 1788, who m. Irena, d. of William Thompson, of Middleboro, and had Daniel F., born in Middleboro, 1827. NATHANIEL, 1st in the text; son Richard born 1646; Jabez, 1647. NATHANIEL, 2d in the text; strike out the marriage of d. Hannah where the name first occurs, and insert it after Hannah in the next line, also erase the words "of Greenwich, Eng." PELHAM WINSLOW, in the text, m. 1825. PHINEAS, son of Joshua above, m., 1730, Grace, d. of Joseph Hastings, of Waltham, and d. in Waltham, 1797; he had thirteen children born, among them William, born 1751. RICHARD, 1st in the text; son of Christopher doubtful, as is also the wife stated. RICHARD, 2d in the text, m. a wife Sarah; erase the words "and John May." SAMUEL, in the text, m., 1703, Eleanor Billington; son Benjamin born 1720; son Josiah, 1724; son Cornelius, 1709; add children Joseph, 1715; Joanna, 1717; Sarah, 1722; Nathan, 1712; James, 1710. SAMUEL, Middleboro, son of above, m., 1734, Rebecca Dunham. SYLVANUS, Middleboro, son of Benjamin above, m. Reine Booth, 1774, and Sarah Washburn, 1782. WILLIAM, m., 1774, Elizabeth King. WILLIAM, son of Phineas above, m., 1777, Rebecca or (Robey), d. of Joshua Hathaway, of Freetown, and died in Worcester, 1831; he had nine children, and among them George, born in Watertown, 1789. WINSLOW, in the text; d. Mary Ann born 1835, and d. Caroline should be Caroline Bartlett.

WASHBURN, ELISHA, 1st in the text, m. 1729; add child Hannah, 1737, m. Thomas Davis. GEORGE, m., 1810, Margaret James Keen. JOHN, 1st in the text, came with wife and two sons in 1635, in the *Elizabeth and Ann* from Eversham, England; his wife was named Margaret. PHILIP, 2d in the text, m. Silence Davis of Kingston. SETH, 1st in the text; son Ephraim born 1794.

WATERMAN, ICHABOD, m., 1757, Hannah Rogers, of Kingston. JOSIAH, in the text, m. 1756. Samuel, in the text, had a wife Mercy, by whom he had Anna, 1693; by a 2d wife, Bethiah, he had Samuel, 1703; John, 1704; Hannah, 1706.
